

Giving Statements:

Next steps:

At our recent winter business meeting, on a membership vote of 77 to 3, the decision was made to formally dissolve the ministry of The Journey North Community Church. The 80 members in attendance either in person or participating virtually represented a quorum of current TJN members. The decision to end the 20-year run of the church was not taken lightly, but rather very thoughtfully and with a great deal of emotion. With this decision, the way is now being paved to turn the property over to Eagle Brook Church, with the hopes of a renewed vision to reach central Minnesota for Christ. While there is sadness in the ending of one ministry, there is excitement for what lies ahead for the church under a new banner. While the name on the building will change, the

mission to reach the lost will remain intact. Our hope is that all who currently call The Journey North their home will continue to support the ministry as it transitions to Eagle Brook. There is much work to be done in preparation for the transition to a new ministry and there will be many opportunities for people to help with the change. One question that may be on the minds of many is a timeline for the ministry. At this point, our best estimate has the ministry of TJN continuing into late spring or early summer, with more information to come to you in the next few weeks. I would like to personally thank you for your continued support for the church through what has been a very challenging period in our ministry's history. Connie and I have been blessed by TJN for over 18 years and we cherish the relationships we have been fortunate to develop. We look forward to see what God has in store!

You anoint my head with oil = CONSECRATION


My cup overflows = ABUNDANCE
